Although applicants don't require a connection to FRA to apply for Foundation awards, it is important to note that 14 of the 24 recipients are, or are related to, FRA Shipmates. "Our scholarship program is a high interest issue to prospective members. Shipmates should mention these scholarship opportunities when interacting with Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard personnel," suggests Barnes.
